ACTS OF TERRORISM, GRUESOME MURDER OF MR. OSORDI KINGSLEY OGUGUA, ATTEMPTED MURDER OF CHIEF JERRY NKEWESHE, MR FELIX ASUKU, SOME POLICE OFFICERS FROM SPECIAL INVESTIGATION UNIT(SIU) ABUJA AT ONICHA OLONA, DELTA STATE AND ILLEGAL POSSESSION AND USE OF ASSORTED FIRE ARMS BY NGOZI OKAFOR, OLUCHUKWU OHAJINTU, IFEANYI ISIEKWENEMGBU, CHIBUZOR UKWADIA, CHARLES OHAJINTU, ONYEISI OHAJINTU, CHIEDU ANWUZIA (A.K.A VIROS), ZICO ENYI, CHRIS IKEZUE (A.KA. ICHIE), DANIEL KOKWUGA, SAM ODIH, PETER ADIMACHI, GODSPOER ANWUZIA, OKAFOR NWAKANNA EKUNNE, ONYEISI AZUKA, MABEL ISIEKWENEMGBU, MRS CHIBUZOR OKAFOR, AND OTHERS. - REQUEST TO URGENTLY ARREST AND PROSECUTE THESE ARMED CRIMINAL ELEMENTS OPERATING IN ONICHA OLONA ANIOCHA NORTH L.G.A, DELTA STATE

We are Solicitors to **Chief Jerry Nkeweshe** and **Mr. Felix Asuku** (hereinafter referred to as “our Clients”), on whose behalf and firm instructions we respectfully submit this petition concerning the brutal and unlawful killing of **Mr. Osordi Kingsley Ogugua**, which occurred at **Onicha Olona**, Aniocha North Local Government Area, Delta State.

On Monday 19th day of May, 2025, the day of the incident, the late Mr. Ogugua, alongside our Clients and Police Officers from the Special Investigation Unit (SIU), visited Onicha Olona to document and photograph the remains of buildings recently burnt down by these same criminal elements and their co- conspirators who are thugs and lackeys reportedly under the control and influence of **Mr. Emma Bazim Chinye**, Chairman of Aniocha North Local Government Area.

Shockingly, during this lawful and police-supervised activity, they were ambushed and fired upon by a heavily armed gang comprising:

This unprovoked and coordinated attack led to the tragic and instantaneous death of **Mr. Osordi Kingsley Ogugua**, who sustained fatal gunshot wounds in the process and whose remains has been

deposited in the morgue by the Divisional Police Officer of Onicha Olona Police Division.

The primary shooter, **Mr. Ngozi Okafor**, whose gunshot resulted in the death of Mr Osordi Kingsley Ogugua, is a known criminal and gang leader, previously arrested in Issele-Uku with an illegal firearm. Despite his criminal history, he continues to enjoy the protection and political cover of **Mr. Emma Bazim Chinye**, thereby evading justice while actively engaging in gunrunning, armed robbery, kidnapping, arson, and terrorism.

Disturbingly, several of these gang members were earlier arrested by men of the Force CID but were released on bail to **Mr. Chinye**, who has consistently refused to produce them before police authorities in Abuja, despite repeated formal invitations.

More troubling is the conduct of the **Commissioner of Police, Delta State**, who, rather than aid in the proper investigation and arrest of the suspects involved in these heinous crimes, has been actively working against the directive of the Inspector General of Police (IGP). The office of the IGP had issued a clear instruction that these suspects, including one **Mr. Paul Okwusindi**, be charged to court in respect of the offences of **arson, terrorism, and attempted murder**.

However, we regret to inform you that the Commissioner of Police, Delta State Command, directed SIU officers on a sister investigation to **release** Mr. Paul Okwusindi, after he had been arrested for repeatedly ignoring police invitations to Abuja regarding these crimes.

Even more concerning is the fact that the same Commissioner of Police has allegedly been pressuring and **attempting to manipulate the investigators (who were present and victims of the attack that resulted in the death of Mr Osordi Kingsley Ogugua)** by coercing the SIU officers to **implicate Chief Jerry Nkeweshe**—whose brother was the slain Mr. Osordi Kingsley Ogugua—as the **aggressor** in the very incident that led to his brother's death. This shameful attempt to twist the

narrative serves only to protect the true culprits and subvert the course of justice.

It is important to mention that the incident that resulted in the death of Mr Osordi Kingsley Ogugua and the attempted murder of our clients would have been avoided, if the police authority at the Delta State Police Command headquarters in Asaba had taken necessary steps to comply with the directives of the Inspector General of Police by arresting these felons and bringing them to justice.

In view of the foregoing and in the overriding interest of justice and public order, we respectfully request that your esteemed office:

1. **Immediately open and intensify investigation** into the murder of Mr. Osordi Kingsley Ogugua.
2. **Swiftly arrest all the known suspects**, including those earlier released to Mr. Emma Chinye, and bring them to justice.
3. **Compel Mr. Chinye to produce all suspects** earlier released to him by the Police.
4. **Investigate the actions of the Commissioner of Police, Delta State Command**, with regard to the obstruction of justice, abuse of power, and attempt to manipulate investigation outcomes.
5. **Ensure the full implementation of the IGP's directive** to charge Paul Okwusindi and others to court.

We are confident in your office's commitment to upholding the law and protecting the lives of Nigerian citizens. We urge your immediate intervention in this matter to prevent further breaches of peace and ensure that justice is not only done, but is seen to be done.
